The Erie County Care Facility Administrator directs the day-to-day functions of the 160-bed long-term care facility in accordance with current federal, State and local standards, guidelines and regulations that govern long-term care facilities to assure that the highest degree of quality care is provided to all Care Facility residents at all times. The Erie County Care Facility provides both skilled and intermediate level services. Available resident services include 24-hour professional nursing services, nutritional evaluation and meal planning, social services and family support, physician and pharmaceutical services. Physical, occupational, speech, and psychological therapy services are also available.

In 2010, total census days were 40,150 (98% occupancy), a decrease of 1,923 days from the previous year. Privately funded residents represented 14% of those days, while 71% were Medicaid, 9% Hospice, 4% Medicare, and 2% Commercial Insurances.

Total revenues for the facility in 2010 were \$6,652,233. Facility reserve balances totaled \$71,390 for 2010 year end. The Facility continues to rehabilitate and return to home nearly 50% of all new admissions. ECCF renovated our 32 bed Alzheimer's unit and entered into contract to sell 30 beds at \$18,500 per bed. We also began renovation of an 18 bed all Private Hospice unit.



The Erie County Care Facility is certified for both Medicare and Medicaid
