**11.18 POSSESSION OF UNAUTHORIZED FIREARMS ON AGENCY PREMISES**

Civilian employees of this agency, including Corrections Officers, Dispatchers, Administrative Assistants, and/or any other non-sworn personnel, are forbidden to transport onto the premises of the Erie County Sheriff's Office, or to possess on the premises of the Erie County Sheriff's Office, any firearms. This policy is not applicable to those employees who may be issued a concealed handgun license by the Sheriff of Erie County and/or any other Sheriff of this state, or of any state with a reciprocity agreement with the Ohio Attorney General regarding concealed handgun licenses, provided that any firearms so transported or possessed are secured at all times from unauthorized access or theft.

This policy is also applicable to any property used or controlled by the Erie County Sheriff, to include Sheriff's Office substations.
