The initiating of a Bill of Information (but once a Bill of Information Is filed, parties can e-file to that case); extraditions; Rule 4 proceedings; Request for a Governor's Warrant; criminal miscellaneous cases designated As "MI (including but not limited to subpoenas for person/records, out-of-State subpoenas, oaths, voting records partial reports submitted by Grand Jury, Grand Jury subpoenas, internet services, release records (Google Records, Yahoo records, cell phone records, bank records, medical records, Cell tower pings, state tax records); disposal of property, GPS tracking Devices, and search warrant inventories; out-of-town writ of habeas corpus.
