President Shenigo called the meeting to order at 9:30 a.m. and opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Commissioners welcomed the third graders from the Regional Center for Advanced Academics (RCAA's). Mr. Shenigo explained what the Commissioners' job is and how government works. Sheriff Sigsworth was also present and the third graders were able to ask the Commissioners and Sheriff many questions.

## Public Comment.

## Drainage on Cherry Road.

Mr. Robert Dunn, 12809 Cherry Road, Vermilion, came before the Board to discuss an issue that has been going on for over two years. Mr. Dunn purchased his property in February 2020 and there has been flooding issues since. Mr. Dunn stated his property is being flooded by over 50 homes directly onto his property with no outlet to Lake Erie. He mentioned that he cannot find any records of a culvert ever being constructed on the property. Mr. Dunn has contacted Vermilion Township Road Department, Vermilion Township Trustees, Erie County Soil and Water, Erie County Engineer, Ohio EPA, Erie Regional Planning Commission, and has sat in township meetings and heard others complain of flooding issues. Mr. Dunn stated he spoke with the County Engineer and Assistant Prosecutor Charles Bennett and he offered to place an easement on his property, hoping to make the current ditch larger, but the County Engineer and Assistant Prosecutor Mr. Bennett denied this request.

Mr. Dunn stated that he and Mr. Bennett have disagreed on documentation related to the property having the proper drainage. Mr. Dunn provided documentation he received from a survey company that does not mention culverts, but states that iron pin sets are on the corners of his property. Mr. Dunn also stated his neighbor, two houses to the west, had a survey completed on his property and that survey shows one of the pin locations where the two properties meet.

In response to Mr. Dunn's documentation, He stated that Assistant Prosecutor Charles Bennett sent a letter to Mr. Dunn, on behalf of County Engineer Jack Farschman, stating that a 1976 Culvert Maintenance Responsibility mentions a culvert located on Mr. Dunn's property. Mr. Dunn added that the 1976 Culvert Maintenance Responsibility states the culvert is located from Darrow Road to Mason Road, which is located in front of 8913 Cherry Road, not Mr. Dunn's property.

Mr. Dunn stated that he has spent hours researching the drainage and water laws in Ohio, researching all of the deeds, surveys, and easements in his area, and walked the ditch to figure out why the water is being dumped onto his property. Mr. Dunn requested that the Commissioners look at all the information that he provided to them to help them make a fair decision. The Commissioners stated that all information will be considered and they would speak with County Engineer and Drainage Superintendent Jeremy Blakely.

# Wheatsborough Solar Project.

Mr. Roger Hunker, APEX Clean Energy, introduced Pat Cavanaugh, who is the construction Manager at the site of the Wheatsborough Solar Project.
Mr. Cavanaugh stated they have stated pre-drilling the pylons for the solar panels. He mentioned the Commissioners are welcome to stop out to the site anytime and he would be happy to show them around.
