

**RESOLUTION NUMBER 2019-01**  
**OF THE METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION POLICY**  
**COMMITTEE OF THE ERIE REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION**  
**AMENDING THE TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM AND**  
**APPROVING TRANSPORTATION PROJECTS AS REQUESTED BY THE**  
**CITIES OF SANDUSKY AND VERMILION**

**WHEREAS**, this Committee is the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for Erie County and the Lorain County portion of the City of Vermilion; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the responsibility of this Committee to approve federally-funded transportation projects from Erie County which appear on the TIP; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Sandusky has requested MPO funding for the Monroe Street Reconstruction Project in the City of Sandusky; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Vermilion has requested MPO funding for the Sunnyside Road Resurfacing Project in the City of Vermilion; and

**WHEREAS**, the MPO Policy Committee has approved \$759,427 in Surface Transportation Funding to be utilized for the construction phase in SFY 2023 for the Monroe Street Reconstruction Project in the City of Sandusky;

**WHEREAS**, the MPO Policy Committee has approved \$825,606 in Surface Transportation Funding to be utilized for the construction phase in SFY 2022 for the Vermilion Road Resurfacing Project in the City of Vermilion;


**WHEREAS**, the MPO Policy Committee has considered and approved amending the TIP to approve the funding for the identified projects; and

**WHEREAS**, approving the TIP amendment will ensure the project is completed on a timely basis; and

**WHEREAS**, the Policy Committee has analyzed this request and found it to be consistent with the long range plans of the Erie Regional Planning Commission;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:**

- 1) That this Committee approves an amendment to the FY 2020-2023 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) as requested by the City of Sandusky and City of Vermilion to include the two (2) projects further described in the attached; and
- 2) That this Committee authorizes Erie Regional Planning Commission staff to provide copies of this Resolution to the appropriate agencies as evidence of action by the Erie Metropolitan Planning Organization.

**Resolution 2019-01 Project Descriptions:**

- 1.) City of Sandusky East Monroe Street Reconstruction Project – Reconstruction of roadway section between Meigs Street and Decatur Street in the City of Sandusky to include full depth pavement repairs, replacing the brick base with concrete, and installing a new asphalt riding surface to reestablish the structural integrity of the pavement. Total project cost estimated at \$951,000. MPO Surface Transportation Program Funds approved for the Construction Phase in SFY 2023 for \$759,427.
  
- 2.) City of Vermilion Sunnyside Road Resurfacing Phase I Project - The total project cost estimated at \$1,111,393 where total MPO approved funding is in the amount of \$825,606 in Surface Transportation Program Funds in SFY 2022. The project will consist of pavement repair and resurfacing of the existing asphalt roadway from 350' north of Jerusalem Road to 800' north of the Norfolk/Southern grade crossing in the City of Vermilion.
