

Erie County to consider Sewer and Water rates

In April 2019, the Erie County Commissioners held public hearings on the likely economic impacts of a recent U.S. EPA Consent Order on wastewater operations. The Board of Commissioners are setting aside time on their agendas to discuss, and take public input to address rates to support compliance with the EPA. They will also consider water supplier and operational cost increases.

The dates for these conversations are January 13th and 20th, at 9:30 am in the Commission Chambers. That location is on the 3rd floor of the Erie County Services Center, at 2900 Columbus Avenue in Perkins Township. Due to COVID mandates, anyone attending in person must wear a face covering.
