## **RULE 21 - MEASUREMENTS, TESTS AND ANALYSES**

**Section 1.** All measurements, tests and analyses of the characteristics of water and wastes to which reference is made in these Rules shall be determined in accordance with the latest edition of "Standard Methods for the Examination of Water and Wastewater" as prepared, approved and published jointly by the American Public Health Association (APHA), American Water Works Association (AWWA), the Water Pollution Control Federation (WPCF) and Federal Regulation 40 CFR 136, and shall be determined at the control manholes or sampling stations provided for in Rule 20 above, or upon suitable samples taken at said control manholes or sampling stations.

**Section 2.** Any wastewater discharger that is sampled and tested by Erie County shall be assessed a fee for said sampling and testing. The discharger shall be assessed a \$25.00 fee for each sampling event and assessed applicable testing fees per the Erie County Laboratory Price List for Analysis of Water and Wastewater as follows:
