

RULE 23 - LEAKS IN SERVICE LINES

Section 1. The County shall repair leaks in service lines between the public water main and the meter pit at no cost to the property owner or consumer, subject to the conditions stipulated in Rule 2, Section 3.

Section 2. The County shall replace service lines between the public water main and the meter pit that are determined to be beyond repair at no cost to the property owner or consumer, subject to the conditions stipulated in Rule 2, Section 3.

Section 3. When a leak occurs in a service line located on private property, the owner of such property shall be responsible for its repair or, if irreparable, its replacement, subject to the conditions stipulated in Rule 2, Section 3. Failure of the property owner to satisfactorily repair any such leak within a reasonable time after being notified by the County of the existence of the leak, shall constitute sufficient cause for the County to discontinue water service to the premises until proper repairs have been affected.
