♦ Power & Control


This is called the Power & Control Wheel*. It was developed after many women described the common tactics their abusers used to control them. At the center of the wheel is the intention of all the tactics--to establish power and control. Each spoke of the wheel represents a particular tactic. The rim of the wheel--which gives it strength and holds it together--is physical abuse. You may or may not identify with each spoke or with the physical abuse; focus on the parts of the wheel that relate to your situation.

♦ Equality

This is called the Equality Wheel*. It was developed to demonstrate the characteristics of a relationship based on mutuality, respect, and equality. The rim of the wheel--which gives it strength and holds it together--is non-violence (emotional and physical).
